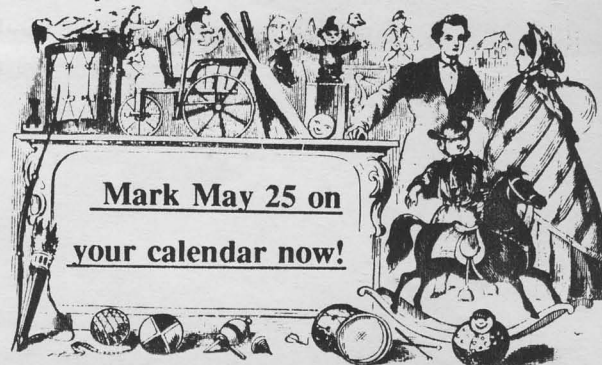
## BEACH TRIANGLE GIANT GARAGE SALE - MAY 25 (RAINDATE MAY 26)
